INTRODUCTION

History of Hawaii's Family Court Reporting System

The Hawaii State Judiciary (the Judiciary) initiated a family court data collection system in 1961 with additional data elements being added in 1971. The batch system is operated and maintained by a private data processing company. The authority for the Judiciary to collect the data is stated in Hawaii Revised Statutes Section 601-3.

Caseload activity output for the local courts are generated quarterly. A special report produced bi-annually contains the age of pending cases and demographic information. The data are also used for the Judiciary's annual report, budget and variance report, and legislative and external data requests.

Data Collection Methods

Each of the four family courts in Hawaii's four circuits participates in the data collection system by submitting initial referral and disposition encoding forms to the Judiciary's Administrative Office of the Courts on a weekly basis. Data are collected on delinquency (law and traffic violators), status offense, abuse and neglect, interstate compact, marital consent and miscellaneous cases such as voluntary admission to a mental health facility. Court clerks complete the initiating reports at the time of referral. The reporting of dispositional information is done either by the clerks or a court statistician. Once received by the Administrative Office of the Courts, the forms are sent to an outside data processing firm for keypunching. Numerous validity and internal data checks are built into the information system to help ensure accuracy.

Publications

Each fiscal year the Judiciary publishes an annual report and statistical supplement, which includes summaries of family court activity based on the collected data. [*State of Hawaii Annual Report*, the Judiciary.]

Archived Data Files

The data files received by the National Juvenile Court Data Archive are offense-level fiscal data files. This means that for each delinquency, status, dependency, or special proceeding offense occurring from July through June of the following year, there is one record in the file. The Archive staff converts these data files into case-level yearly files.

In converting offense-level data to case-level, records having the same CIRCUIT (HI003), CHILD ID (HI004), and MONTH/DATE/YEAR CASE FILED (HI009, HI010, HI011) are grouped into one case. Once a group of records is identified, one of these records is selected to represent the base information of the case. This selection is based on offense, disposition, and date of disposition. First, the most serious offense of the group is identified. If only one record contains that offense, then that record is selected. If more than one record contains the most serious offense, then the most severe disposition is identified from among those records. If more than one record contains both the most serious offense and the most severe disposition, then the record having the latest date of disposition is selected. (Seriousness and severity hierarchies were developed by Archive staff and are presented in Appendix I and in the notes accompanying the created variables.)

Having selected a base offense to represent a case, the other offenses are then summarized into "created" variables. This summarization results in variables such as the most serious finding, most serious final charge associated with the most serious finding, most severe disposition, etc. These variables provide a more complete view of a case that involved more than one offense.

The data in the files are stored as numeric characters (which are whole numbers) unless otherwise noted. . The records for each case in the 1986-1995 data files are 217 characters in length and contain 61 variables. The data are stored in single year files. The number of case records in each calendar year data file is as follows:

Summary tabulations for delinquency, status offense, and dependency/neglect cases for each county in Hawaii are publicly available beginning with 1982 data through the Inter-university Consortium for Political and Social Research at the University of Michigan, P.O. Box 1248, Ann Arbor, Michigan. 48106.

USING THE CODEBOOK

The information that follows is based on a study of available documentation from the data supplier (e.g., instructions for completing Family Court Report #6), interviews with the data supplier and court personnel, and diagnostic analyses performed by the Archive staff. The example below is a reproduction of information appearing in the codebook for a typical variable. The numbers in brackets do not appear in the codebook, but are references to the descriptions that follow this example.

[1] The starting location and width of the variable in the machine-readable data file: This is the format information needed to read the data into other systems.

[2] The variable number: The variable number is used as a variable name when the file is processed by systems that use alphabetic variable names (e.g. SPSS).

- [3] The variable label used by statistical systems to identify the variable or program output.
- [4] A description of the variable contents:
- [5] The code values occurring in the data for the variable: If the variable is a year, the symbol ## represents the most current year for which data are available.
- [6] The textual definitions of the codes: The first 20 characters form a short value label which some systems use to document the output of analysis programs. A longer description follows the short label when necessary.
- [7] The designation of missing data: The Archive staff has replaced any out-of-bounds codes with missing data codes. Many analysis packages require that certain types of data that are usually excluded from analysis be designated as "missing data". Fields with no entry were left blank and "() No entry" is listed as a code value. Some variables also have response options representing "unknown" which are also listed as code values.


STATEMENT OF ACCEPTANCE
